Owners should anticipate that their pet will be shaved and their RVVS visit will take approximately 45 to 60 minutes. To obtain the best diagnostic results, it is preferable for the patient to have an *empty stomach and full bladder* at time of ultrasound. As soon as the ultrasound is complete, you can expect to receive a written report of the patient's ultrasound.
